

## Information Sheet on SILVANUS webinar event & the processing of personal data

06-06-2023

Dear Participant,

SILVANUS project has the privilege of hosting a 2-hour online webinar as part of the EU Green Week 2023. On these pages you will find information about the processing of your personal data associated with the webinar event of SILVANUS project. Personal data related to this event will be processed in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679.

The goal of SILVANUS is the development of a technological and climate-resilient integrated forest management platform in the fight against extreme wildfire. Currently in the middle of its second year, SILVANUS has made significant advancements, in particular by initiating the 1<sup>st</sup> trial period of pilots that will test the platform.

Two pilots (out of total 12 in 11 countries, including Brazil, Indonesia and Australia) have been implemented in Croatia and Slovakia, where technologies such as far-edge IoT devices for smoke detection, unmanned ground vehicles for water dispersion and aerial deployment for fire mitigation were validated. Data has been acquired for improvements in the integration of all the technological components that will make the SILVANUS platform an innovative and essential tool in fire prevention, suppression, and biodiversity restoration. These will be presented during the webinar.

Description of the activities of the citizen engagement programme, emphasising the success of the SILVANUS promotional and educational campaigns on fire suppression and prevention, will also be highlighted.

After the presentations there will be time for discussion and ideas. We urge you to become part of the webinar and actively participate in it by raising any questions or exchanging ideas with us.

Within the frame of this interactive process, your name will appear on the side of the screen, unless you sign in anonymously or with the name of your Company/Institution in which case, it is only this name that will appear.

In addition, **the webinar will be recorded, and we aim to publish the webinar on social platforms**, therefore the content will be accessible from all over the world. If you do not wish your image/voice to be registered, you have the option not to switch on your camera/microphone. However, in case you do so, your image/voice will be recorded and published on processed for the purpose below.

The event takes place online. Your participation is totally voluntary, you may leave the event at any time. If you have any queries related to the Project you may contact us through <https://silvanus-project.eu/contact/>.

**Personal data processed are:**

- Contact information such as name, surname, organization, email address.
- Audio and/or audiovisual recordings of groups of participants (attendees and/or speakers) and organizers, if you switch on the camera or microphone.

**Purpose:**

The purposes of the processing of your personal data are the management and organization of the webinar, information sharing, initiation of discussions and dissemination of the activity:

- Your e-mail address, name and surname for organizational, documentation purposes as well as to further contact you in the context of this Project, if you have consented to such communication.
- Your name/surname should you choose to sign in in the webinar with your name, for technical reasons.
- Your voice/image will be processed for storage, documentation and dissemination purposes, if you switch on the camera or microphone.

We will not use personal data for any other purpose, unless a new legal basis exists, in which case you will be notified or asked for renewed consent with full information about the further processing.

**Legal basis:**

Personal data is collected **based on your consent** [Article 6, 1(a) GDPR].

**Data controller:**

Micro Digital as the organizer of the webinar and PEGASO as the Coordinator of the SILVANUS project are the Data Controllers of your personal data's processing for the purposes explicitly identified above.

Micro Digital and PEGASO will collect and use the above-mentioned personal information only to the extent necessary for organizational purposes, to provide you with information about this event and process your application to participate. Where necessary, we may also share your information with service providers for the purposes of organizing the event and associated events.

**Recipients:** Micro Digital and PEGASO may share Identifiers and contact information such as name, surname, organization, email address with the rest of the SILVANUS Consortium (<https://silvanus-project.eu/about/consortium/>) if you have agreed to be further contacted for the purpose of SILVANUS Project. We underline that SILVANUS Project is a HORIZON 2020 project that includes international partners. Therefore, if you agree to be further contacted (always within the purposes of the Project), your name and email may be shared with our Partners from Australia, Brazil and Indonesia.

Access to Audio and/or audiovisual recording of the webinar (therefore your voice and image if you have switched on your camera/microphone) shall be given all over the world once the event is published on social platforms.

#### **Transfer to non-EU countries:**

Considering that the webinar shall take place online, and that the recorded webinar will be published on social platforms data mentioned above will be processed outside the EU (if you switch on your microphone, announce your name, turn your camera on).

In addition, you should be informed that YAYASAN AMIKOM YOGYAKARTA (AMIKOM), established in Indonesia, COMMONWEALTH SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATION (CSIRO), established in Australia and COPPETEC Foundation, established in Brazil are part of SILVANUS Consortium. No adequacy decision has been issued from the EC for these countries. Therefore, if you have agreed to be contacted for further communication on the activities of the Project, your data may be transferred to these partners established outside the EU for the specific purpose, i.e. to further communicate with you in the context of the specific project. Transfer to those partners will be made in accordance with Chapter V of the GDPR, art. 49 par. 1 a). Any processing of personal data by this partner will be made according to the national legislation and the necessary safeguards will be implemented.

#### **Personal Data Retention:**

Personal data on the Consent Form (name and surname) will be retained by the data controllers during the lifecycle of the project and for a 5-year period after its completion according to SILVANUS Grant Agreement. More particularly, your e-mail address (if you consent to further communication) will be retained during the lifecycle of the project (in case of the project's necessary extension, by the end of the agreed with the European Commission extended period); your image and/or voice (if registered – this

depends on whether you will switch on the camera/microphone) will be retained during the lifecycle of the project (in case of the project's necessary extension, by the end of the agreed with the European Commission extended period). After this period, the information will be permanently deleted from the Consortium's databases, however, the webinar published online (social platforms) may subsist.

The appropriate safeguards (technical and organizational measures) will be implemented to prevent any unauthorised access, loss, destruction, transfer of your personal information.

### Your Rights:

You have the right to:

- Request information about whether we hold personal information about you, and, if so, what that information is and why we are holding/using it.
- Request access to your personal information (commonly known as a "data subject access request"). This enables you to receive a copy of the personal information we hold about you and to check that we are lawfully processing it.
- Request rectification of the personal information that we hold about you. This enables you to have any incomplete or inaccurate information we hold about you corrected.
- Request erasure of your personal information. This enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal information where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it.
- Request the restriction of processing of your personal information. This enables you to ask us to suspend the processing of personal information about you.
- Request transfer of your personal information in an electronic and structured form to you or to another party (commonly known as a right to "data portability"). This enables you to take your data from us in an electronically useable format and to be able to transfer your data to another party in an electronically useable format.

Withdraw consent: when our use of your personal data is based on your consent, you have the option to withdraw your consent to our processing and delete your personal data at any time by sending us an email at [igor.krsic@microdigital.eu](mailto:igor.krsic@microdigital.eu) and/or [delio.iazzetti@unipegaso.it](mailto:delio.iazzetti@unipegaso.it). Once we have received notification that you have withdrawn your consent, we will no longer process your personal information for the purpose or purposes you originally agreed to, unless we have another legitimate basis for doing so in law. This means that if you want us to delete your personal data from our repositories at any point in time after you have given your consent, please contact us and we will do so immediately. Please note that the withdrawal does not affect the processing of your data which is based on the consent you have given before the withdrawal.
